Introduction

This tribute to mothers makes use of scripture from the New Testament book of Galatians, chapter 5, verses 22-23 as its theme:

“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace,
longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.”

Galatians 5:22-23

The apostle Paul, in his letter to the churches of Galatia implores the believers in Jesus Christ to avoid the desires of their carnal, human nature (the flesh) and instead, “Walk in the Spirit.” (Galatians 5:16). The “fruit” (benefit or outcome) of living and walking in God’s Spirit and will, as Paul explains, is: love, joy, peace, longsuffering (patience), gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness (humility) and temperance (self-control).

Jesus promised that after his resurrection and return to heaven, to be with God, the Father, he would not leave us alone. In John 15:26 through 16:15, Jesus indicated that he would send the Comforter (a Helper), also known as the Holy Spirit, to be with us until he returns from heaven.

I thank my wife, Judith, for her suggestion that this booklet begin and end with Sunday. This structure allowed me to come full circle with the Lord’s Day and use eight of the nine aspects of the fruit of the Spirit.


If you want salvation today, please pray this prayer:
