All Patty wanted was to feel normal, so she ate the apple with no questions asked.

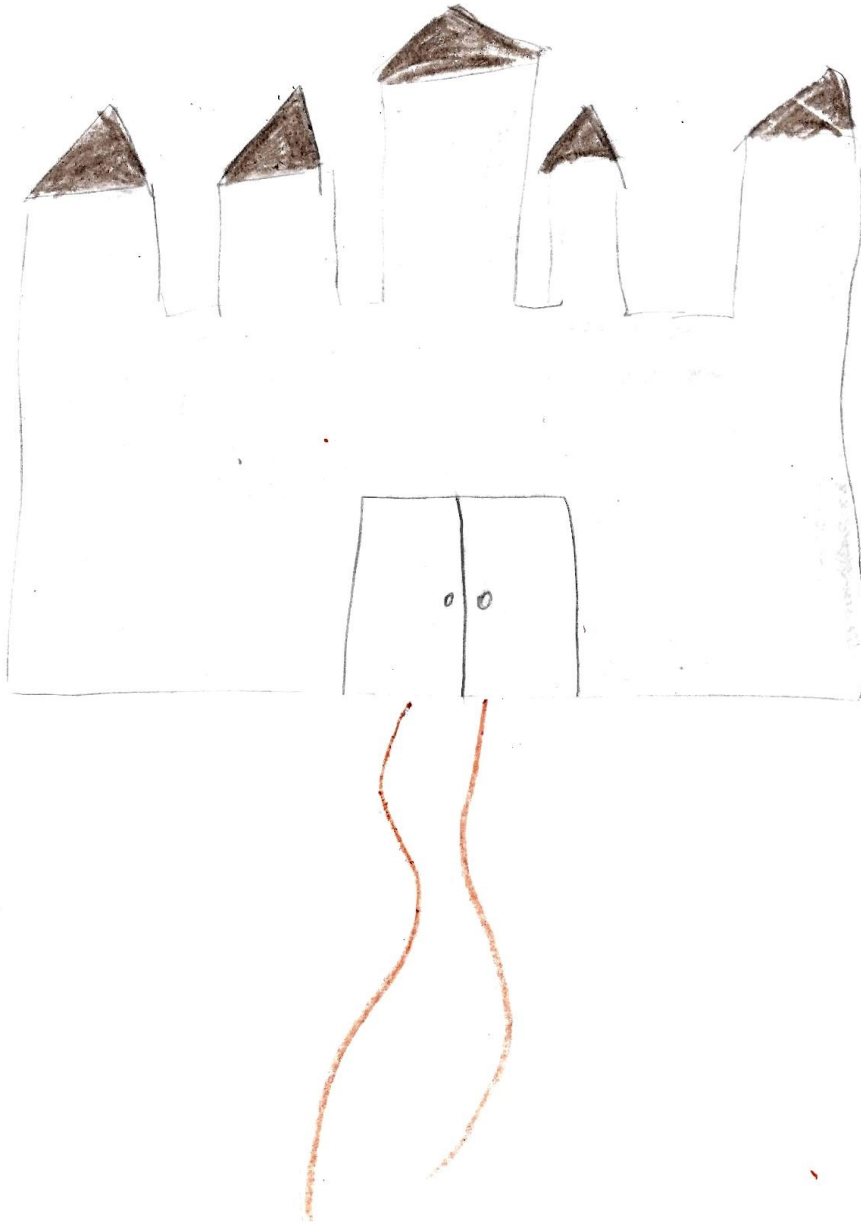


The next thing she knew she became a he. For once in Patty's life, she felt like she belonged. Patty changed his name to Pat.

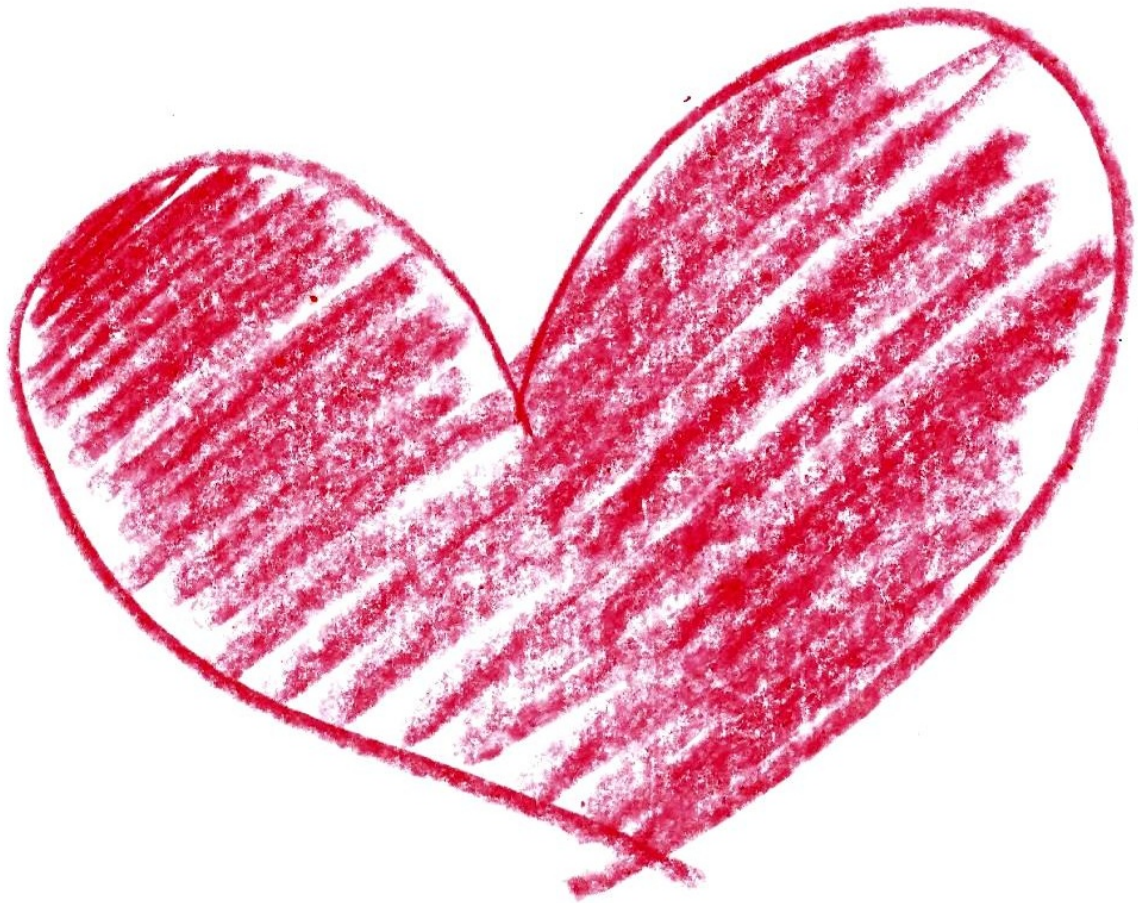
